### Enriching the Lives of Children in Haiti and Sri Lanka

In Haiti, the city of Petit Guave was one of the cities badly affected by the 2010 earthquake, and today many people are still living in sheds. At present 200 orphans and young students from very poor families are studying in a school called Ecole Village Lucina. IMHO is providing breakfast daily to all students as part of a nutrition program so that the students can focus on their studies. Each meal is just \$0.15 (fifteen cents) per child, and IMHO has already given enough support (\$4,100) to support the program for one full year. This project is being implemented locally by the Dr. Henri Gerard Desgranges Foundation, which IMHO has partnered with since the devastating earthquake of January 2010. IMHO has supported the HGD Foundation in various ways over the past several years, including support for shipping a donated ambulance, sending several shipments of in-kind donations of medicines and medical supplies, and visits by IMHO volunteers.

Another unique child-centered effort that recently took place was the reconstruction of a home for a young boy and his elderly grandmother who tragically lost their home in a fire. IMHO provided assistance in the amount of \$1,600 to help
