IMHO AGM and 14th Annual Convention -2017

Kudos to our supporters and well-wishers in Georgia and volunteers from IMHO Florida for a Successful 2017 Convention! Over 200 Volunteers, well-wishers, and donors attended the 2017 14th Annual IMHO Convention on Saturday, June 17 at the Lanier High School, Sugar Hill, Georgia. The Keynote Speaker was Dr.V.Sarveswaran with Assist Resettlement & Renaissance (ARR), a registered NGO in Sri Lanka who spoke about the need to support the resettled families with shelters and livelihood in Sampoor in the Trincomalee District. The program also included a presentation by Dr.S.Raguraj, President, IMHO International Board, on the projects completed thus far and the current needs with an emphasis on uplifting the marginalized communities including the underprivileged in the Upcountry area, Saree Auction, Bharatha Natyam and fusion dances culminating with the dinner, music and entertainment. The Junior Leadership Program (JLP) held in the morning was attended by nearly 40 students and industry professionals. They participated in many round discussions addressing educational advancement, professional and social networking needs. A concluding panel discussion also included contributing to IMHO projects.

The event raised over \$110,000 including a contribution by a matching donor. The funds raised will help support several projects including but not limited to Sampoor housing and livelihood, Upcountry community humanitarian needs, Palliative Care, Autism Centers, Disabled Toilets, provision of livelihood opportunities and other urgent needs.

Sri Lanka Flood Disaster Relief

Intense rainfall in May sparked widespread flooding and landslides devastating the south-western parts of Sri Lanka. IMHO partnered with Assist Resettlement & Renaissance (ARR), a local NGO whose staff delivered relief supplies to the affected communities especially in Ratnapura and Kalutara. Based on the needs assessment, school supplies to children were also hand delivered. Items were bought and distributed to about 1,200 affected children from five Ratnapura schools. Initially the volunteers distributed emergency relief items such as water, bread, milk powder etc. in Kalutara. IMHO contributed \$5000 for this relief effort.

#The Autism Center "Theeraniyam" was recently opened, thanks to the Brothers of Charity providing the space and building which was renovated. The Center, first of its kind to the district will bring enhanced awareness and assistance to the local community.

Upcountry (Maskeliya, Hatton):

Additional fund raising will help complete the ongoing and new projects. Moving forward, IMHO board has approved \$50,000 for building 60 additional shelters in Sampoor and also initially giving 5 (out of 10) boats and nets to help the fishing families for livelihood. Additional educational projects including Reading Groups for children, Saving Groups for the estate communities are also being planned for the Upcountry area in Maskeliya with the help of Empowering For Development (E4D) in addition to the contribution for toilets working with World Vision in Hatton.
