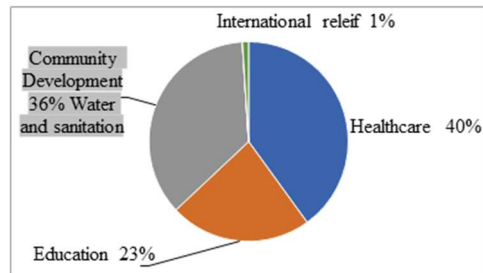

Sri Lankan Projects and International COVID Surge Relief Updates

We have ongoing projects to support education, healthcare, and community development including livelihood, water and sanitation. Due to the recent COVID-19 surge in Sri Lanka and India, relief efforts have been made to address the urgent healthcare needs as shown below.

Project Expenses Jan – Dec 2020

Total Program Service Expenses...\$552,162



COVID Relief May 2021

India \$10,000

Sri Lanka **Initial** COVID Relief \$55,000

- Indian relief through Doctors without Borders
- Sri Lanka Initial Relief: 10 Oxygen Concentrators to Northern hospitals, 2 each to Trinco and Batticaloa hospitals, 15 pulse oximeters, Basic equipment to Maskeliya hospital/ Nuwaraeliya.
- Logistics are being worked out separately by IMHO USA to ship needed equipment including ventilators. (Donated by ONE UMM, USA) to hospitals in SL.
- Board approved Emergency Equipment for Mullaitivu DGH COVID- 19 treatment unit with Transport Incubator, Multipara monitors and CPAP (\$23,000)

Needs Going Forward – Healthcare & Community Development

- Cataract Project w/ Assist RR UK, 1000 Cataract Surgeries, Cost \$40 EA
- Upcountry Housing Project Partnering with World Vision , \$2,925/ house, IMHO contribution \$1,755/house, 25 houses, benefit plantation worker families affected by damaged housing
- 75-80 Poor Children Heart Surgery Project with Rotary Club, IMHO contribution \$20,000.
- Additional COVID surge relief support

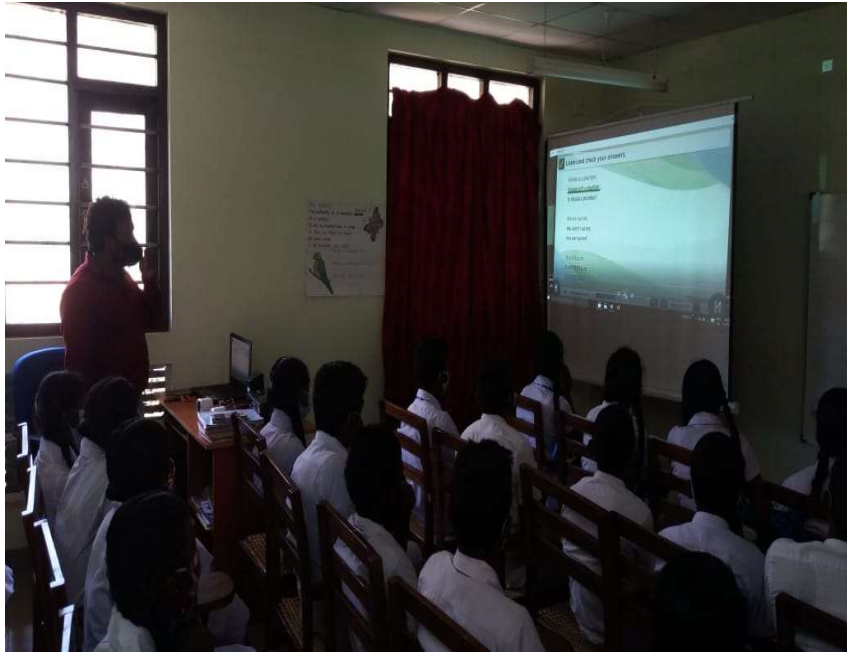
