

Construction of an Intermediate Care Unit for Mentally III patients.



Jaipur Rehabilitation Centre

IMHO has been closely collaborating with Jaffna Jaipur Rehabilitation Centre for over 12 years to provide rehabilitation services for people with physical disabilities.

The aforementioned services include mobility devices, wheelchairs, artificial limbs, and physiotherapy services.

We also support educational grants for children with disabilities.

Total Cost: \$7,500



Staff Support

- Research shows that the quality of healthcare services is directly related to the quantity and specialized training of healthcare workers.
- IMHO has been supporting the staff in underserved and underprivileged areas for the past 18 years

EARLY CHILDHOOD CARE DEVELOPMENT - ECCD

- Early childhood education is the basis for any child's physical, intellectual, and emotional development.
- At pre-school, children build a strong foundation in social, pre-academic, and general life skills that will give them a leg up in school and beyond.
- Research shows that children who graduate from preschool have improved academic readiness, lower incarceration rates, and higher earnings than others.
- IMHO supports 159 children from 11 preschools in Central Province. In April 2022, 62 students from these schools received their admissions for grade 1 at government schools.
- IMHO supports the aforementioned preschools with resources such as staff salaries, electricity, furniture, educational equipment, outdoor play equipment, and renovations.
- Total Cost: \$ 10,330

Activity Based Oral English(ABOE) Program

- Aims to improve English teaching skills for Grade 1 and 2.
- 400 English teachers of 20 schools in Northern Province were selected for the training.
- 40 teachers from North-Western province will be trained.
- Total Project Cost: \$ 3,600





Improving Reading Skills of Students

- "Reading is an essential part of education"
- · Barathy Reading Hut is located at Brownlow Estate, Maskeliya.
- It was renovated by IMHO and inaugurated on October 30th,
 2021 to improve the students' reading and leadership skills.
- Additionally, IMHO has donated furniture and 186 books for the wellbeing of the students. In the beginning, the students had to stand to read the books. Now they have a comfortable spot to sit down and read. Encouraging the students to read will improve their standard of education, their general knowledge, and their lifestyle.
- Adults have also been encouraged to read as much as they can.
 They are allowed to select their own reading materials including newspapers and various other books.
- There are 58 active reading groups running in 30 locations.
 In total, they serve 960 children.
- Total Project Cost to renovate Barathy reading room: \$ 2,000







EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT IN CENTRAL AND SABARAGAMUWA PROVINCES

- Due to teacher shortages, students were at a great disadvantage with entering higher education. To alleviate this situation, IMHO donated approximately 1 million LKR worth of materials and resources to 300 students of Nivithigala education zone.
- Supplemental English classes were provided for students in Hatton Educational Zone Division III.
- In 2021, 600 underperforming students were selected in Hatton Zone and conducted special coaching classes to help them succeed in O/L examinations in subjects such as science, math, history, and Tamil.
- Total Cost: \$ 4,100










Caring Hands Project

- IMHO supports 120 destitute children from Maskeliya and 100 from Kotagala. These children were forced to stop their education in order to provide for their families. IMHO has intervened by providing their families with 3000 LKR worth of dry rations every month.
- This additional support has allowed the children in question to return to school.
- Total Cost: \$ 35,000/year









School Water Supply & Sanitation Project

IMHO aims to develop the holistic educational experience of school-aged children in Hill Country areas. In the past, students and the teachers have been gravely affected without access to clean water facilities and sanitation. IMHO continues to support the schools in meeting these needs.

More than 25,000 students and about 850 teachers at 25 different schools have benefitted so far.

Total cost since 2016 - \$ 50,000







Water Supply & Sanitation Project

Outcomes

Studies show that students do better in schools when they are emotionally and physically healthy. They miss fewer classes, are less likely to engage in antisocial behavior, concentrate more and achieve higher test scores

Vast improvement in attendance. They can spend their free time at the library and laboratory to improve their general knowledge.

Teachers can also teach their students without any disturbance as all facilities are available to them in their respective schools.





Provision of Nutritious Meals to School Children

- Due to the current economic crisis, many children come to school without breakfast or lunch. IMHO addresses this issue with school-based nutrition programs.
- 1100 school children from Central Province (\$ 9,600 for 3 months)
- 450 children at 11 different preschools in Kilinochchi district through World Vision (\$ 6,329 for 3 months)
- 286 children of 9 pre-schools in Batticaloa district (\$ 2,500 for 3 months)
- 159 preschool children from Maskeliya (\$ 1,400 for 3 months)
- 85 students from Chenaiyoor Madya Maha Vidyalayam School
- 130 students from KK/ Pondugalchenai Ganapathy Vidhyalam and Kotmale Shanmuga Vidyalayam (\$ 1,150 for 3 months)



Advance Level Students Scholarship Program

- Access to education is a major barrier to students from low-income families. For this reason, Nadarajah Foundation in association with IMHO USA provide scholarships to A-level students in Nuwara Eliya, Kandy, and Matala. The scholarships cover tuition and transport fees.
- During the 2019 and 2020 school years, over 100 students were selected for scholarships. In 2020, 65 students sat for G.C.E. (A/L) examinations. 40 students qualified for postgraduate studies at universities and teachers' colleges.

COVID 19 Pandemic Response

- Dry rations were provided to selected families in Northern, Eastern and Central Province
- More than 10,000 families benefited.
- Total Cost: \$ 50,000.





COVID 19 Pandemic Response

- IMHO's mission is to support the most vulnerable communities during times of need.
- Distribution of dry rations to 162 families with differently abled children in Vanni area.
- 200 people affected with cancer received LKR
 5,000 worth of dry rations.
- 60 hearing impaired families also received LKR

Building Sustainable Livelihood

Home Gardening Project

- Food insecurity is currently a major issue worldwide. It is particularly prevalent in Sri Lanka. To alleviate this issue, IMHO began a Home Garden Project in February 2021.
- Approximately 1,500 people received seeds and basic gardening equipment to cultivate their own vegetables. They were also taught basic gardening skills. IMHO funds LKR 150,000 for this project every month.
- This project has given participants both financial and nutritional relief.
- "I suffered a lot before I did home gardening in the prevailing situation in Sri Lanka. However, now I can manage the family without debts by taking cultivated vegetables for our use and selling the balance of it to meet our urgent needs".
- Total Cost: LKR 150,000/month

Community Development

- In collaboration with World Vision, IMHO agreed to fund 25 houses for homeless individuals in Central Province. To date, 5 houses have been completed. IMHO's contribution\$ 8000/5 houses
- We also collaborated with World Vision to construct 100 sanitation facilities in Central Province. IMHO's contribution \$15,000
- In collaboration with International Rotary Club, we are also aiming to build 250 additional sanitation facilities in Central Province
